

To Small and Medium-sized Enterprises in Hokkaido We Support Your Infection Prevention Measures!

In order to prevent the spread of the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19), we will offer support for the equipment, etc. purchased by businesses who have stores and provide face-to-face service, in order to strengthen infection prevention measures.

Subsidy Amount

Subsidy upper limit: 75,000 yen

Subsidy rate: within 3/4

*The amount of subsidy excludes tax, and is rounded down to the nearest thousand yen.

*Application is limited to once per business



Application Acceptance

■ e-learning course period

*First-come-first-served basis for each session

[1st session] Jul. 30 (Fri) to Aug. 31, 2021 (Tue)
[2nd session] Sep. 1 (Wed) to Dec. 17, 2021 (Fri)



*Please be aware of the following:

- To apply for the subsidy, you need to **take an e-learning course and understanding check and obtain a certificate of completion.**
(If you would like to take the course on paper, please contact the call center.)
- Each session will be accepted **on a first-come, first-served basis, and the course will be closed when the planned number of attendees is reached.**
(The attendance status will be announced on the secretariat website.)

*Please be aware of the following:

- **Applications from those who do not have a certificate of completion of the e-learning course will not be accepted.**
- Please take the e-learning course in advance and receive a certificate of completion.

Target Beneficiary

Small and medium-sized enterprises in Hokkaido (small and medium-sized enterprises with headquarters or main offices in Hokkaido or individual enterprises with addresses in Hokkaido) stipulated in Article 2 of the Small and Medium-sized Enterprise Basic Act (Act No. 154 of 1963), which have stores in Hokkaido and provide face-to-face services in their main business.

*Business consultation and reception spaces in the office are also **eligible.**
(e.g.) Restaurants, retail stores, cram schools, beauty salons, gyms, kitchen cars, etc.



Target Expenses

Equipment purchased, installed, and paid from Jun. 18, 2021 (Fri) until the application date

Examples	① To prevent droplet infection	Acrylic board, protective screen *Excludes self-made acrylic boards and vinyl curtains
	② To prevent contact infection	Non-contact thermometer, thermo camera, non-contact soap dispenser, foot-operated disinfectant stand, non-contact disinfectant dispenser, non-contact ordering system, and automatic water tap
	③ To prevent infection by ventilation	Air purifier(*), circulator, electric fan(*), ventilation fan, CO2 sensor(*), air conditioner with ventilation function, humidifier(*), net window (also applicable to re-covering of net) *There are criteria or conditions such as capability.
	④ Other	Shipping and installation costs associated with the introduction and installation of the above purchased equipment are also covered.

Requirements

- ① Infection prevention measures should be implemented based on industry-specific guidelines.
- ② Take the e-learning course produced by the secretariat in advance and formulate a plan for infection prevention measures.
- ③ Accept the on-site confirmation survey conducted by the secretariat.
- ④ You should not have applied for or received other subsidies, etc. implemented by the national government, municipalities, etc. regarding the equipment, etc. that you apply for as a subsidy target.
- ⑤ Restaurant businesses must have a restaurant business license or a coffee shop business license

Method, etc.



- ① Take e-learning course from the secretariat website or QR code and receive a certificate of completion
- ② Formulate a plan for infection prevention measures using the application form
- ③ Send the application form by mail (simplified registered mail, etc.)
