

Duration of requirements

**From Mon., Feb. 21 to Sun., Mar. 6, 2022**

Target facilities

<b>Restaurants and other dining establishments</b>	Restaurants and other dining establishments (including Japanese-style pubs [izakaya]), cafes and coffee shops, etc. (*excluding delivery services and to-go services) <b>that are licensed to operate restaurants or coffee shops under the Food Sanitation Act</b>
<b>Entertainment facilities</b>	Cabaret clubs, karaoke boxes, etc., that have a restaurant business license and karaoke boxes that do not have a restaurant business license under the Food Sanitation Act
<b>Wedding venues</b>	Wedding venues, etc. that are licensed to operate a restaurant under the Food Sanitation Act (including hotels and Japanese inns [limited to the parts used for gatherings] where wedding receptions, etc. are held)

Requirement details

**Hokkaido infection control certified establishments**

- Select one of the following **(the initial selection cannot be changed)**

**Business hours: 5:00–21:00**  
**Alcoholic beverages: 11:00–20:00**

or

**Business hours: 5:00–20:00**  
**Alcoholic beverages: suspended all day long**

**Uncertified establishments**

**Business hours: 5:00–20:00**  
**Alcoholic beverages: suspended all day long**

**Note: If you become a certified establishment during the request period, the request will be changed to that of a certified establishment from the day you receive the certification.**

\*The provision of alcoholic beverages includes the bringing of alcoholic beverages into the dining establishment by users.

- **Groups consisting of up to 4 persons per table may enter an establishment in principle.**

\*The vaccine and testing package system will not be applied to all eligible persons.

## Major payment requirements

### Complying with the requirements through the entire period from February 21 to March 6, 2022

\*To apply, we plan to request applicants to submit photographs demonstrating the information about the shortened business hours or closing down, as well as other documents such as a copy of the necessary business permit that proves compliance with the requirements.

\*A support fund will be provided to establishments that have obtained a business license as a “restaurant” or “cafe and coffee shop” by the day before the requirements started (Sun., Feb. 20, 2022), and that actually operate the business.

After 21:00	Select one of the following (the original selection cannot be changed) (1) Shorter hours of operation from 5:00 to 20:00 (alcoholic beverage service suspended) (2) Shorter hours from 5:00 to 21:00 (alcoholic beverages served from 11:00 to 20:00)	

## Amount of support funds

Small and medium enterprises/sole proprietor	83,333 yen or less	$25,000 \times 25 = 625,000$
	Over 83,333 yen to 250,000 yen or less	$25,000 \text{ to } 75,000 \times 25 = 625,000 \text{ to } 1,875,000$
	Over 250,000 yen	$75,000 \times 25 = 1,875,000$
Large-scale company	Up to 5 million yen depending on the amount of the decrease in sales (per establishment, per day) <sup>1</sup>	

(2) Business hours: 5:00 to 20:00; stop serving alcoholic beverages all day long

	Sales (per establishment per day)	Amount of the support fund for 25 days
Small and medium enterprises/sole proprietor	75,000 yen or less	$30,000 \times 25 = 750,000$
	Over 75,000 yen to 250,000 yen or less	$30,000 \text{ to } 100,000 \times 25 = 750,000 \text{ to } 2,500,000$
	Over 250,000 yen	$100,000 \times 25 = 2,500,000$
Large-scale company	Up to 5 million yen depending on the amount of the decrease in sales (per establishment, per day) <sup>1</sup>	

### Uncertified establishments

Business hours: 5:00 to 20:00; stop serving alcoholic beverages all day long

	Sales (per establishment per day)	Amount of the support fund for 25 days
Small and medium enterprises/sole proprietor	75,000 yen or less	$30,000 \times 25 = 750,000$
	Over 75,000 yen to 250,000 yen or less	$30,000 \text{ to } 100,000 \times 25 = 750,000 \text{ to } 2,500,000$
	Over 250,000 yen	$100,000 \times 25 = 2,500,000$
Large-scale company	Up to 5 million yen depending on the amount of the decrease in sales (per establishment, per day) <sup>1</sup>	

\*1: Small and medium enterprises and sole proprietors can use the same method as large companies to calculate the amount of support).

• Method of calculating the unit price of support per day (Large companies use B, small and medium enterprises and sole proprietors can use A or B)

A. For (1), sales per day in January to February 2019, 2020 or 2021  $\times 0.3$  (for (2) and non-certified establishments,  $\times 0.4$ )

B. For (1), (2), and uncertified establishments, the decrease in sales per day in January to February 2019, 2020 or 2021  $\times 0.4$ <sup>2</sup>

However, for (1), the amount is the lower of <sup>2</sup> or the daily sales amount for the period from January to February 2019, 2020 or 2021  $\times 0.3$
